#### WHY IT WORKS

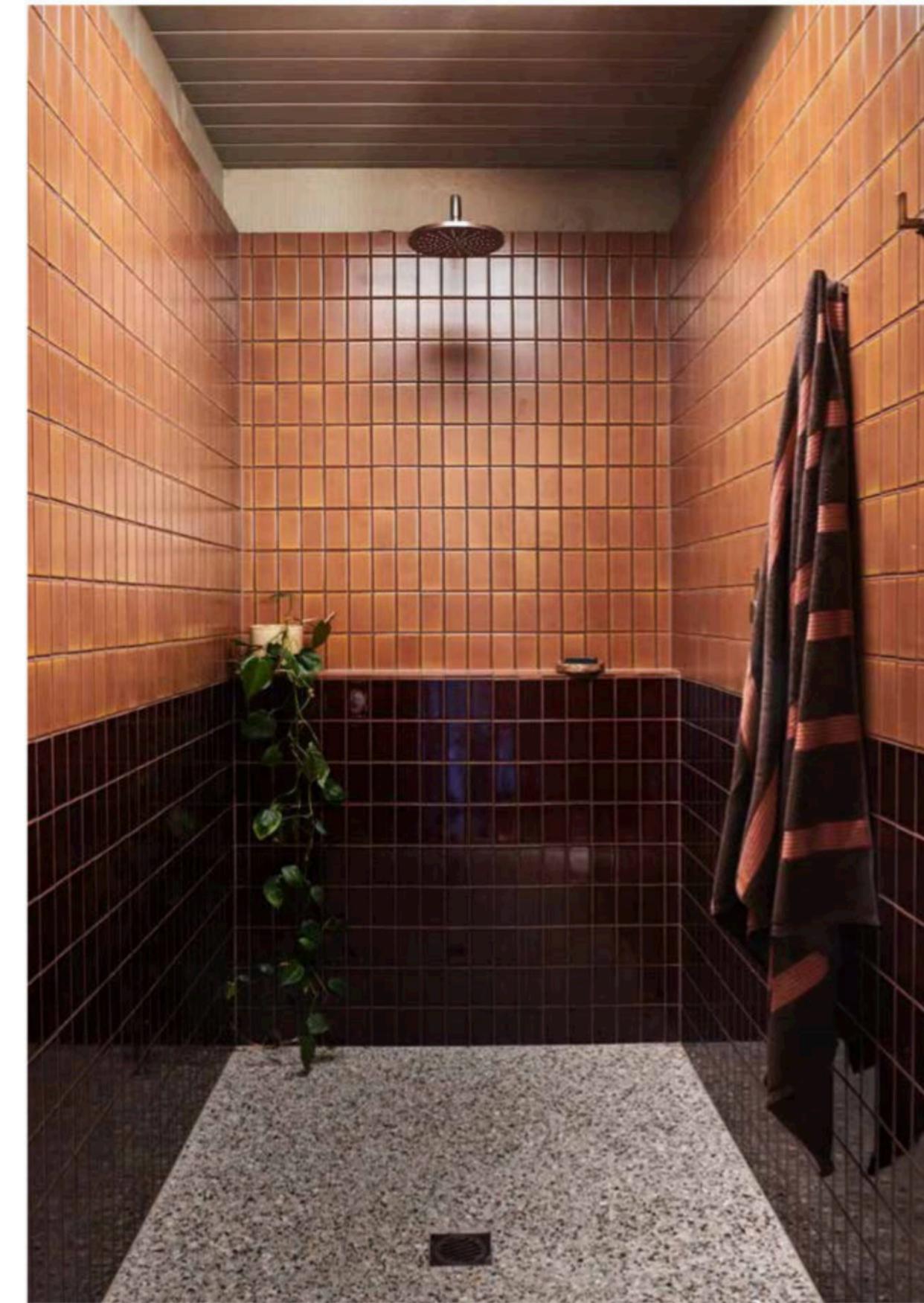
**FLASHBACK** Terrazzo floor tiles from Fibonacci tiles scream ‘good old days’.
